Sauvignon has become one of the world's best loved grapes and whilst it started life in the Loire Valley of in France, perhaps more people have encountered it in its New Zealand guise. Originating not far from where the Takahé bird was rediscovered, this wine has all the intense characteristics of a classic NZ Sauvignon in abundance.

There's an enticing citrus aroma, with just a hint of tropical fruit, a clean fruity palate that evokes elderflower and a fine, complex finish. All this means that although the wines is a deliciously refreshing glass on its own, there is plenty of potential for food pairings with the likes of grilled fish, stir fries, grilled Mediterranean vegetables and even mild curries.



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
